God, through the words of Jeremiah, you promised to bring forth a new king from the line of David. Your Son, Jesus, is that promised king. We pray as we wait to celebrate the birth of your Son, Jesus, and that through him your love and justice would prevail. Amen.

CARING CONVERSATION

Take a moment to check in with each other or to use the questions below.

- **Highs & Lows:** Name one new thing that happened today. Name one boring thing that happened today.
- Thinking about This Week's Story: God's people were living in exile nowhere near their homeland. Jeremiah's role was to share some good news with the people that God had not forgotten them. What good news did you hear today?
- **Getting Ready for Next Week's Story:** A shepherd is someone who protects and cares for their sheep. Who cared for you today? What did they do for you?

Read aloud from the DAILY BIBLE READING from the front. What do you want to remember from this reading?
