DEVOTIONS

Think about devotions as a continuation of our community's worship. The following basic pattern could be one way of forming your household's devotions. Adapt as necessary!

GATHERING

♣ Light a candle to help you focus this time as "God time."

☆ Praver of the Week

O Lord, even in her uncertainty and fear, Esther acted and brought life to her people. Even when we are uncertain about your presence in our lives, remind us to act and bring life to others, as you have acted and brought us life in Jesus, whose birth we wait to celebrate. Amen.

CARING CONVERSATION

Take a moment to check in with each other or to use the questions below.

- **Highs & Lows:** Name one strong thing you did today. Name one thing you did today that was not so strong.
- Thinking about This Week's Story: Esther was a strong leader for her community. She saved her people, the Israelites, from destruction. Who is a strong leader that you met today? A teacher? A pastor? A friend? What makes their leadership strong?
- Getting Ready for Next Week's Story: Isaiah announces to the people that there will be a new servant. God promises that this new servant will bring justice and peace for all. Name one way that you kept the peace today.

DAILY BIBLE READING

Read aloud from the DAILY BIBLE READING from the front. What do you want to remember from this reading?

PRAY TOGETHER

[♣] Sit still together for one minute. During that one minute, pray silently. At the end of one minute, say together, "Amen."

CLOSING

If you used a candle, extinguish it as a sign of the end of the devotion time.

P Rituals & Traditions: A Blessing to Share

With permission, mark one another with the sign of the cross each other's hands or forehead, and say, "May God be with you at this time and on this day. Amen."
